## PARADE

- All Riders must wear a harness or ride at your own risk.
- Mask must be worn during the parade.
- Costumes must be worn at all times.
- All Riders should be loaded on their float no later than 5:00pm.
- Participants that consume alcohol participate at their own risk.
- Playing music with vulgar lyrics and profanity is not allowed.
- Items left on your float must be retrieved by 10:00 am the day after the parade.
- Riders should not exit the float during the parade. Riders should remain on your float until the float reaches the Civic Center. While on River West drive we ask you remain on your float until it is pulled forward to the Civic Center.
- Children under the age of 18 must wear a harness.
- Children between the ages of 14 to 21 are allowed to ride with adult supervision. The maximum child to adult ratio is 3 to 1. For every three riders between the ages of 14 to 21, you must have one adult responsible for those three riders.
- Floats are “smoke free.” No smoking is allowed on the floats.
- Riders should not hang off the side, front or back of floats.
- Riders will be responsible for any intentional damage done to floats.
- Float Captains, Krewe Board and or the Police can exercise their authority to remove unruly or disruptive riders.

## PARADE THROWS

- Throws may be purchased through the Krewe of Comogo. See dates above for purchase date deadline. All throws purchase from entities other than the Krewe of Comogo must be approved by the Board of the Krewe. The day of the parade your throws will be inspected and are subject to being pulled from your float.
- Beads must be metallic with a minimum size of #8.
- Business throws may have their logo however; the Krewe of Comogo logo and or name must appear on the throw and requires Board Approval.
- No political throws are allowed.
- Do not throw any items that are vulgar, offensive or inappropriate for a family oriented parade.
- Do not throw food items of any sort including candy.
- Do not throw items belonging to other Krewes, parades, or companies. (Unless approved by Board)
- No sharp or dangerous pointed throws.
- No glass, can's or metal throws.
- No items considered too heavy to throw.
- Never intentionally throw an item with the intent to harm someone.



## GALA

- If members have not selected their seating location 2 weeks prior to the Gala, the Krewe Board will designate assigned seating. Members are not assigned an entire table. Seats are per ticket so you may be paired with other members at one table.
- Dress code is Business Casual or Parade Costume.
- You must have a wrist band to enter the Gala.
- Please use the main entrance when entering and exiting the building.
- Security is provided for your safety.
- The band will be "Louisiana."
